Starring Richard Roxburgh, Julian Maroun, Rahel Romahn and Yael Stone, The Correspondent was written by Peter Duncan and produced by Carmel Travers. An exclusive Q&A with Peter Greste, Kriv Stenders, Director (Red Dog, Danger Close: The Battle of Long Tan) and Carmel Travers, Producer will follow the screening at 8pm.

The Correspondent releases in cinemas on Boxing Day.
